Top SUV – 2005 Range Rover HSE

Next up on the list...the top NADAGuides.com SUV pick. According to Perleberg, the 2005 Range Rover HSE was the hands-down favorite with several key features that made the grade, including stand-alone SUV styling, a rugged drive train and a Bentley-like interior. “This vehicle has off-road capabilities that will astonish even the most serious four-wheelers,” said Perleberg.

Top Classic Car – 1970 Plymouth Barracuda Hemi

With 425hp and 490lb-ft of torque this car was capable of 0-60 in 5.6 seconds and could reach the quarter mile finish line in 13.41 seconds at a top speed of over 104 mph. “Limited production numbers make this fun-to-drive classic a great investment as well,” said Steve Ferguson, classic car editor at NADAGuides.com.

Top RV – 2005 Pace Arrow 36D/23’ Slide-Out
